### IRAN: The Lives of Iran's Political Prisoners Are in Imminent Danger

Can You Hear Their Screams?

Can you hear the suffering of political prisoners in Iran amid the violent conflict between the Israeli government and the regime in Iran?

Can you hear the anguished cries of families silenced after the Israeli strike on Evin Prison?

**Can you hear the footsteps dragging prisoners into darkness, toward torture, isolation, and execution?**

#### After the Bombs, the Regime Strikes from Within

On the night of June 23, 2025, Israeli forces targeted Evin Prison. In the chaos that followed, the regime in Iran moved swiftly, not to protect, but to **punish**. According to credible reports and video footage received by the Campaign to Free Political Prisoners in Iran (CFPPI), dozens of buses arrived at Evin in the early hours of June 24. Political prisoners, several were injured in the attack, were loaded onto the buses and **forcibly transferred to undisclosed locations**. Families have not heard from their loved ones. The authorities refuse to provide answers. The silence is unbearable. The fear is real.

This is not new. For years, the regime in Iran has tried to **dismantle Evin's political prisoner wing**, dispersing detainees into non-political prisons where they face even greater risks, torture, neglect, and execution. Now, using the aftermath of the airstrike as cover, they've succeeded and then the regime will claim, there are no political prisoners and the Evin prison is shut!

#### A Legal Weapon: The Judiciary's War on the People

Since the conflict began, the regime in Iran and its Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) have arrested hundreds of civilians simply for filming or photographing explosions.

The regime has cut internet access nationwide to silence voices and prevent communication. Security forces patrol with impunity, searching cars, phones, and threatening citizens. Hours after the announcement of a ceasefire by Donald Trump, the regime's judiciary escalated repression further. Spokesperson Asghar Jahangir declared a dangerous amendment to the regime's espionage laws, dramatically broadening the definition to criminalize ordinary civilians under fabricated charges of "collaboration with Israel."

This legal manoeuvre is a green light for mass executions, targeting journalists, students, activists, and anyone daring to speak out. Several executions have already been confirmed this week, including: Esmail Fekri, Majid Mosayebi, Mohammad Amin Mahdavi Shayesteh. How many more will be silenced before the world acts?

### **Evin Prison Must Fall by the People's Will, Not Bombs**

CFPPI condemns the attack on Evin Prison and the Islamic regime's use of war as a pretext for atrocities against its own people. Evin must fall, not by bombs from above, but through the resistance and courage of the Iranian people.

### **A Global Outcry Is Urgently Needed**
